### Sharing the Care Plan

Pfizer drugs are available to patients who are 200% or below federal poverty level. Only a dispensing fee is charged. NOTE: These drugs may **only** be prescribed to patients with sliding scale pay who have no drug insurance coverage, including Medicaid and Medicare. These medications are identified with the symbol “STC”

### Patient Assistance Program

Patients who meet specific income requirements are eligible to receive certain medications through manufacturer-sponsored patient assistance programs (PAPs). Medications in marked with the “pound (#)” symbol are available to eligible patients through manufacturer-sponsored PAPs. These medications may not be readily available and may require up to a 6-week processing period.

### Lab Monitoring

Some commonly used drugs require laboratory monitoring and are identified with the symbol “LAB”.
